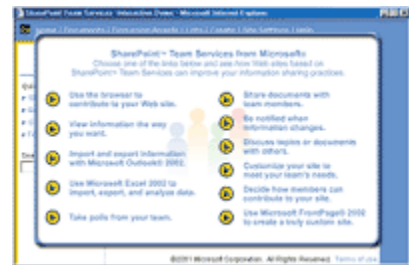

Preformatted templates let your team members contribute to the SharePoint® Team Services-based website simply by filling out lists. You'll find forms for announcements, events, contacts, tasks, surveys, discussions, and links. SharePoint® Team Services also makes it easy to create custom lists by building on existing forms, or creating new ones from scratch.

Document Libraries.

One of SharePoint®'s handiest features is the Document Library. This provides a central location for archiving and sharing all of your team's work, and a plain web browser interface makes accessibility a breeze. By assigning templates to the libraries you can ensure that all the documents remain consistent and compatible among all your team members. A simple text-based search function and familiar folder views help facilitate finding documents within the SharePoint® team library.

Team Interaction.

SharePoint® helps team members exchange ideas through subscriptions and notifications that alert everyone to website changes, while inline document discussions make it easy to collaborate on specific deliverables without altering the original documents. Another way to keep your team together is through SharePoint®'s discussion boards, which serve as a central forum for specific topics, and surveys, which are a useful way to get targeted responses to key issues.



Team Management.

Once you've launched a SharePoint® Team Services-based website, a simple email invitation serves to register team members to the site. You can assign different permission levels to each member, depending on their role. Date, time, and author stamping makes it easy to track member participation. web-based administration lets you manage user accounts quickly and simply from within the browser.
